

Daughter of West Parish's 13th Pastor Robert Samuel (1883-1886), Grand Daughter of our 7th Pastor Enoch Pratt (1807-1835), and Great Grand Daughter of Deacon Braley Jenkins (1825), Dr. Samuel gave the first donation to the Restoration Fund in 1929 with the challenge "to let us begin" restoring the 1717 Meetinghouse to its original design and footprint. They were arranged by Chris Haven.

Text to Give

If you haven't tried it out, it's easy:

- 1. Text 866-586-0169 (the give-by-text number for West Parish) and in the body of the message enter the amount you wish to donate and send.
- 2. You will receive a registration link. Click on it, enter your contact and payment information then press "Process."
- 3. After registration is complete, you will receive a verification text and receipt via email.

You only need to register and set up your payment information once. For future giving, simply send a text with the amount you wish to give, and it will process automatically.
