

#### INVITATION

#### PRAYER OF COMMUNION

#### DISTRIBUTION OF THE ELEMENTS

Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way after supper, he took the cup, saying: "This cup is the new covenant sealed in my blood, shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of me."

Thank you to Rev. Pamela Wannie for leading us in worship this afternoon. She is delighted to be here at West Parish Church, a place that she holds close to her heart. Currently, Pam is the Founding Pastor of Here Now Ministries, an outdoor ministry whose mission is to build bridges between the housed and unhoused communities on Cape Cod. Additionally, her full time call is as a Spiritual Care Provider and manager of a Zero Suicide Initiative at Duffy Health Center.

Rev. Wannie is a 2016 graduate of Andover Newton Theological Seminary where she received a Masters of Divinity with certificates in Pastoral Care and Ministerial Leadership. Additionally she has certificates in Church Renewal and Vitality through the Center for Progressive Renewal, Conflict Transformation through the Brookfield Institute and is a certified Grief Counselor. Pam has also authored "Our Common Home" as part of the larger work "One Nation Indivisible: Seeking Liberty and Justice from the Pulpit to the Streets" (2019).

Prior to being ordained in 2017, Pam was a professional minister of music, music educator and accompanist. She lives on Cape Cod with her husband Adam, a mental health clinician, and with her two college-age children who spent their early years here at West Parish preschool where Pam taught preschool music.

Our "Saturday School" is underway, a special class for our youngsters, held over in Jenkins Hall, led by Pastor Reed and an adult lay teacher/volunteer, during the last 20 minutes of the service. Interested in joining in as a teacher or an extra pair of hands, speak to Reed after church.
