

(Our service of communion is open to all seeking Christ's presence. Whether children receive the elements we leave to their parents' discretion.)

INVITATION

One: The voice of God speaks: "Listen, all you who thirst, come to the waters, and you that have no money, come buy and eat!

Many: Come buy juice and milk without price. Why do you spend your money on bread which will not satisfy? Come to me, that you may have life."

All: Come, let us break bread together.



PRAYER OF COMMUNION

Holy God of wind and fire, your Spirit renews the face of the earth and warms the hearts of your people. We give you thanks for your gifts of Pentecostal power: tongues that utter prophetic words of truth and justice: flames that kindle new visions of compassion and peace; fresh breezes that blow down the walls which separate us from you and one another. And so it is that we join with every voice and tongue on earth and in the heavens to give you praise.

DISTRIBUTION OF THE FLEMENTS

(We offer a covid-safe communion cup and wafer system of grape juice and cracker.)

On the night before he died, Jesus took bread, and after giving thanks, he broke it, and gave it to those sitting around him, saying, "take, eat. This is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way after supper, he took the cup, saying: "This cup is the new covenant sealed in my blood, shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of me."

UNISON PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING

For the bread we have eaten. For the juice we have tasted, for the life we have received, we thank you God. Grant that what we have done and have been given here, may so put its mark on us that it may remain always in our hearts. Grant that we may grow in Christian love and understanding, and that ours may be lives of faithful action, in Christ's name. Amen.


