

(Our service of communion is open to all seeking Christ's presence. Whether children receive the elements we leave to their parents' discretion.) We shall be receiving communion by the ancient practice of intinction.

Come forward, take a piece of the bread, dip it in the cup, and consume it on the way back to your seat.

INVITATION

The Holy One is here and we lift our hearts to the Lord. It is right to give thanks and praise. O God of many names, You made a covenant with Noah and caused nations, in their amazing diversity, to spread over the face of the earth. AS of old you led your people out of a land of enslavement to a land of promise, so, too, you led our ancestors, and some us, into new lands of possibility—there to find you anew.

In the fullness of time, you sent Jesus, in every aspect human as we are. He grew up in a small town in Galilee, far from the seat of religious and civil power. He spoke with an accent. He learned of the breadth of your grace from a Gentile mother. Beside Jacob's well, he was moved by an encounter with a minority woman and disclosed his messianic identity.



PRAYER OF COMMUNION

God, teach us to see like Jesus. To help us, we come to the table to remember how you loved your friends, and the world. Amen.

DISTRIBUTION OF THE ELEMENTS

(We offer a covid-safe communion cup and wafer system of grape juice and cracker.)

On the night before he died, Jesus took bread, and after giving thanks, he broke it,

and gave it to those sitting around him, saying, "take, eat. This is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way after supper, he took the cup, saying: "This cup is the new covenant sealed in my blood, shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of me."
