

INVITATION IONA COMMUNITY

The table of bread and wine is now to be made ready. It is the table of company with Jesus, and all who loved him. It is the sharing with the poor of the world, with whom Jesus identified himself. It is the table of communion with the earth, in which Christ became incarnate.

What set Christians apart, what made them radical, was that in a time of intense political, social and religious divisions, they set a table where all are welcome.

So come to this table, you who have much faith and you who would like to have more; you who have been here often and you who have not been for a long time; you who have tried to follow Jesus, and you who have failed; come.

It is Christ who invites us to meet him here.

#### THE STORY BEHIND THE LAST SUPPER

Blessed is our brother Jesus, who walks with us the road of our world's suffering, and who is known to us in the breaking of bread. On the night of his arrest Jesus took bread and having blessed it he broke the bread and gave it to his disciples, saying,

This is my body, given to you.
in the same way he took wine
and having given thanks for it
he poured it out
and gave the cup to his disciples, saying,
This cup is the new relationship with God,
sealed with my blood.
Take this and share it.
I shall drink wine with you next in the coming Kingdom of God.
