

(Our service of communion is open to all seeking Christ's presence. Whether children receive the elements we leave to their parents' discretion.)

INVITATION

One: Jesus Christ said: I am the bread of life. You who come to me shall not hunger; you who believe in me shall never thirst.

All: In company with all who hunger for spiritual food, we come to this table to know the risen Christ in the sharing of this life-giving bread.

One: This table is for all who wish to know the presence of Christ and to share in the community of God's people.



PRAYER OF COMMUNION

We thank you, God, Creator of us all; from the beginning you made the world and all its creatures. You made people to live for you and for one another. We praise you, O God. You created Adam and Eve and gave them a garden; you showed Noah a rainbow; you gave Moses strength to free your people and taught Miriam to sing; you gave courage to Esther and loyalty to Ruth; you gave David a harp to sing your praise, and helped him defeat the giant. We praise you, O God. Yet, even they turned away from you and forgot about you, as we do too. But you do not forget.

You sent Jesus to the world to show how much you love us and to bring us back to you again. Amen.

DISTRIBUTION OF THE FLEMENTS

(We offer a covid-safe communion cup and wafer system of grape juice and cracker.)

We gather at this table to remember that on the night before he died, Jesus took bread, and after giving blessing it, he broke it, and gave it to those sitting around him, saying, "take, eat. This is my body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way after supper, he took the cup, saying: "This cup is the new covenant sealed in my blood, shed for you for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, do this in remembrance of me."

UNISON PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING

Loving God, you made this wonderful world for us to enjoy. You showed our ancestors how to care for one another. You gave Jesus to be our friend and to bring us closer to you.
